MILWAUKEE (June 1, 2026) — Courage+, Wisconsin's first and only licensed provider of nonprofit LGBTQ+ youth housing, has launched statewide sidewalk art installation titled [Courage to Grow](#) to draw attention to the unseen challenges of LGBTQ+ youth.

In the spirit of pride month, Courage+ is bringing visibility to the streets of Appleton, Madison, Milwaukee and Racine. From suburban sidewalks to restaurant patios, local businesses, also known as **Bravemakers**, are hosting floral installations blooming from the cracks in the sidewalk, telling the people of Wisconsin: It takes courage to grow.

"The 'plus' in our name is a promise; a promise to expand our care beyond safe housing and into the daily lives of LGBTQ+ youth and young adults. Their strength and resilience aren't abstract," said Brad Schlaikowski, founder of Courage+. "These installations are a way of acknowledging their strength and reminding every young person who sees the art installation that they're not alone, and there are people in their community who truly care about them."

What is a Bravemaker?

A Bravemaker is a business, organization or individual that actively demonstrates support for the LGBTQ+ youth community by fostering safe, inclusive environments. Through collaboration with the Courage+ program, Bravemakers commit to ongoing education, visibility and advocacy efforts that empower young people to show up as their authentic selves.
